This four-hour highly interactive general safety workshop is designed specifically for new and young workers entering the performing arts and live event industry. Topics covered include, but are not limited to:

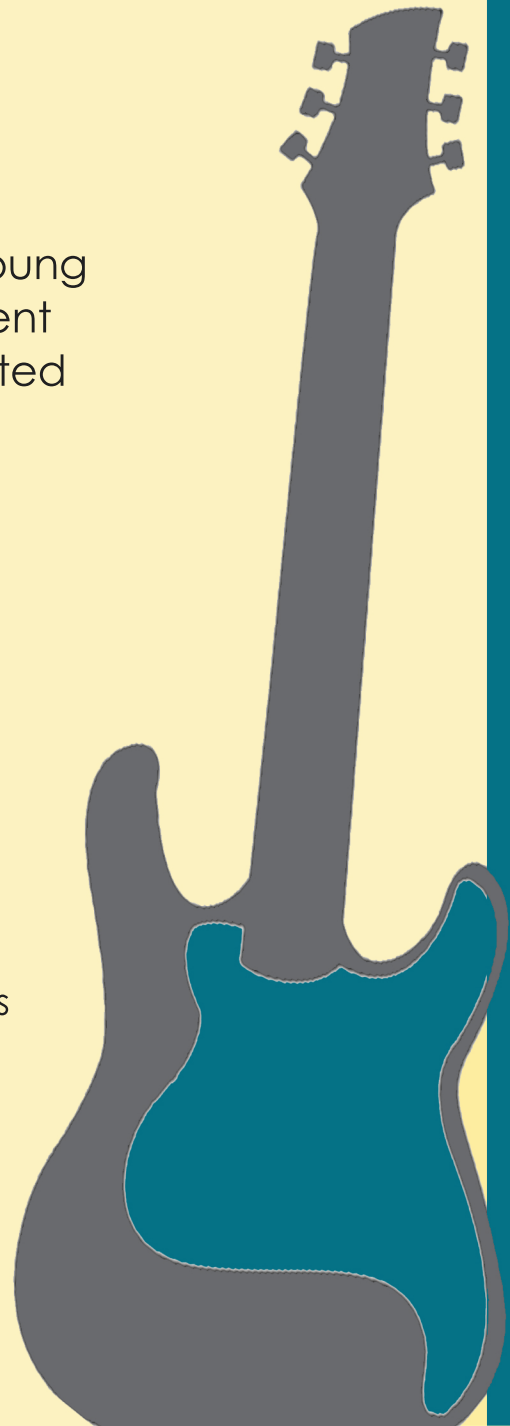
- identifying hazards
